- Please bring your child's bag daily with spare named clothes (at least 2/3 full outfits )—especially since we are coming into summer—we do a lot of water play!!
- Sunblock—From Labour weekend we will start to apply sunblock. We apply at 10.30 and after rest / sleep time—please make sure your child comes with sunblock applied in the morning. If you have your own sunblock please see a teacher and we can organize that. Centre hats are available for the children and are compulsory while they are outside for the summer months.

#### **Process Cooking**

Recently at The Pagoda we have been trying a different type of cooking with the children. Process cooking is a more independent form of cooking. We set up the ingredients and the children follow along the steps and make their own serve, whether it is a pancake, a muffin or a cookie. There is very little teacher influence. Sue Kilgour a kindergarten teacher from Cambridge has written a book which is a great resource to set up process cooking. If you are interested in purchasing a book let us know.







Our recent walk to the town square



Prep time: 10 mins Cook: 50 mins

#### **Ingredients:**

2 Tbsp extra virgin olive oil 1 large brown onion, coarsely grated 3 medium carrots, coarsely grated 1/3 cup plain flour 3 cups milk 1 cup grated pizza cheese 3 cups cooked macaroni 1 bunch chives, finely chopped

#### **Method:**

#### Step 1

Preheat oven to 200°C (180°C fan-forced). Grease a 12-hole, 1/3 cup capacity muffin pan.

#### Step 2

Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Cook onion and carrot for 10 minutes, stirring, or until softened. Sprinkle over the flour, then stir for one minute or until combined. Gradually add milk, stirring to combine. Bring to a simmer, then cook for 10 minutes or until the mixture has thickened. Remove pan from the heat.

#### Step 3

Fold in cheese, macaroni and 3/4 of the chives until the cheese has melted. Spoon mixture into muffin pan. Sprinkle with 1/2 of the remaining chives.

#### Step 4

Bake for 25 minutes or until golden brown. Cool in pan for 10 minutes. Serve topped with remaining chives.
